

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE

April 11, 2023

**Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes**

After review of the minutes of the March 2023 meeting, Jordan Goins made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, Jonett Valentine seconded the motion. The vote was all in favor, with no opposition.

**Financial Report**

The Heritage Commission monthly budget report was not available at meeting time.

**Old Business**

Lynn Shurden informed the commission that she would be able to attend the annual CLG meeting in Water Valley in August, and other commission members may attend if they are able to do so.

The Heritage Commission discussed the proposed historical survey of the Crosstie Historic District. Lisa Miller is compiling a list of the properties which will need to be surveyed. Commission members agreed that a survey of the existing district should be done at this time, but other areas can be looked at another time. Lynn Shurden will check with Meredith Massey at MDAH to make certain the Heritage Commission is in compliance. Jonett Valentine made a motion to re-survey the Crosstie Historic District, and Jordan Goins seconded the motion. The vote was all in favor of the motion.

The Heritage Commission discussed the nomination of a candidate to fill the unexpired term of Mickey Thompson. Cetin Oguz made a motion to nominate Stephen Craddock for the position, and Judy Dilworth seconded the motion. The motion passed with all voting in favor.


