Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

After review of the minutes of the April 2023 meeting, Jordan Goins made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, Jonett Valentine seconded the motion. The vote was all in favor, with no opposition.

Financial Report

The Heritage Commission reviewed the monthly budget report, which was unchanged.

Old Business

Lisa Miller was not available to discuss her work on the Crosstie Historic District survey project. Lynn Shurden will contact Meredith Massey regarding the costs of the survey and ask for a list of people who may be able to perform the survey. The Heritage Commission will check on available grants at the time of the survey.

The Heritage Commission discussed the nomination of Steven Craddock to fill the unexpired term of Mickey Thompson. Mr. Craddock has a city of Cleveland address, but his actual residence is outside the city limits. Judy Dilworth made a motion to amend the ordinance to read that commission members must have a physical Cleveland address, not a Post Office box. Cetin Oguz seconded the motion. The vote was three members in favor of the motion, one member against the motion, and one member abstaining. Mr. Craddock's nomination had been approved by the Heritage Commission and the Mayor and board, and was allowed to stand.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
