Old Business

The Heritage Commission members reviewed the financial report.

Cetin Oguz will be attending the Preservation Bootcamp this month. Corinne Casanova made a motion to approve Cetin's attendance and the associated expenses. Lisa Miller seconded the motion. The vote was all in favor of the motion.

New Business

Cetin Oguz submitted an application to replace the shattered glass in the front window at 110 B South Court Street. He will also replace and paint the wood frame and trim around the glass. Mickey Thompson made a motion to approve the application, and Corinne Casanova seconded the motion. The vote in favor of the motion was unanimous.

Cade Holder of the chamber spoke to the Heritage Commission regarding the new design guidelines. The new guidelines have not been posted to the Heritage Commission website. Other links are also missing from the site.

The chamber will be awarding façade grants to businesses in the Crosstie Historic District. The grant amounts have increased from 500 to 1000 dollars. The business owner will have to submit an application to the Heritage Commission to receive approval for changes to the building façade.
