**Approval of Minutes**

**New Business**

When everything is complete, the Public Arts Committee will meet to approve all documents, and everything will be sent to the Board of Aldermen for approval at the September 6, 2022 board meeting. The Public Arts Committee will issue a press release, or an article, in the Bolivar Bullet to inform the public of the Public Arts Committee and the application process.

When an application is submitted in seamless docs it will go directly to Community Development, where it will be checked to make sure that all information is provided correctly. From there, the application will go to the secretary of the Public Arts Committee for distribution to the committee members. If the application is approved by the PAC, it will then go to the Heritage Commission, if applicable, and then to the Board of Aldermen for final approval.
